GSR.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Farakka Barrage Project , Chief Draftsman Recruitment Rules, 2016 (insofar as they relate to the post of Chief Draftsman), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Chief Draftsman in the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Farakka Barrage Project, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**— (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Farakka Barrage Project, Chief Draftsman Recruitment Rules, 2022.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application.**— These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.** - The number of posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** – The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
5. **Disqualification.** – No person,-
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.** – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving.** – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedules Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

seniors shall also be considered, provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their Juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1 January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth CPC recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission.

Deputation (including short-term contract):

Officers under the Central Government or State Government or Union territory or Public Sector Undertakings or statutory or Universities or recognized research institutions :

(a)(i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department, or

(ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in Pay Matrix Level - 6 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and

(b) possessing the educational qualification and experience as under: Diploma in Engineering (Civil or Mechanical or Electrical) from a recognized Institution along with three years' experience in the relevant field.

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation including short-term contract. Similarly, the deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including the period of deputation the period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years.

Note 3: The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

<p>Note 4: For the purpose of appointment on deputation (including short-term contract) basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommendations has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up gradation.</p>
